Dear Claudie,

The appeal body in relation to decisions under the Dublin regulation has up until recently been the Ministry of Justice. Under the new Dublin regulation the appeal body is the Danish Refugee Appeals Board. The decisions haven't been brought before the courts neither under the old Dublin regulation or under the new. In general the courts have no part in asylum cases in Denmark. The general appeal body is the Danish Refugee Appeals Board, an independent board presided by a High Court judge.

Regarding your second question on refoulement we have no way of identifying such cases.

My name is Claudie Ashonie Wilson and I am a 5th year law student at the Reykjavík University in Iceland.

I am currently working on my thesis regarding asylum issues, more specifically Dublin cases. For the purpose of a comparative analysis, I am hoping that you'll be willing to provide me with information that I was unable to acquire from your website. There are only two questions:

**First:** Would it be possible to gain access to statistics on the number of Dublin cases that have been treated either by the National or Supreme Court between the periods 2010 til to date?

**Second:** Aside from Greece, has there been any other Dublin cases before the Supreme Courts where the "Dublin returnee" contests his removal due to fears of a real risk of refoulement within the meaning of Article 3 ECHR in the country found by Finland to be responsible for examining his application? If so, what are the names of the cases and what were the outcome?
